August Day 2 Monday

Canoeing (1) around [Powell River/Lake Loop: Mitchell Canoe and Kayak](#): \$52 CDN
The Powell Forest Canoe Route encompasses some of the best wilderness areas you'll find on the BC Coast and is easily accessible from various entry points along the way. From Lois Lake you'll access the first leg of the trip up Lois Lake to Horseshoe Lake. The distance is approximately 8.5 km with a portage of 1.7 km between the first two lakes. Campsites are located along Horseshoe River and Horseshoe Lake and on Nanton Lake (25 campsites), this area is frequented by locals, so campsites are at a premium here. Area 6 or 7 Lower Horseshoe (which is at the bottom of Horseshoe Lake) or even better camp at Nanton to ease the second day's km's.

August Day 3 Tuesday

Canoeing (2) around [Powell River/Lake Loop: Mitchell Canoe and Kayak](#): _\$52 CDN Total distance along Horseshoe and Nanton Lakes is approximately 6.5 km with a portage to the next lake, Ireland Lake; of approximately 2.4 km. Ireland Lake is a short 1 km paddle to the next portage at Dodd Lake (.8 km). Dodd Lake has a campsite (12 sites) and is another location well used by the locals. Camp overnight_ Camp area 21, 12, 20 or 31 Nanton or Dodd (west side) as these are large enough to accommodate the group size. We will try to push through to Dodd on this day to keep on schedule with regard to the daily winds on Powell.

August Day 4 Wednesday

Canoeing (3) around [Powell River/Lake Loop: Mitchell Canoe and Kayak](#): _\$52 CDN Length of lake is approximately 7 km. From Dodd Lake you portage (.7 km) to Windsor Lake and paddle for about 2.5 km. There is a small campsite (3 Sites) on Windsor Lake and then portage another 2.5 km to Goat Lake, where you'll also find camping (5 sites). Camp area 16 Goat Lake campsite is your best bet

August Day 5 Thursday

Canoeing (4) around [Powell River/Lake Loop: Mitchell Canoe and Kayak](#): _\$52 CDN Goat Lake is the last lake before you reach the final and largest lake, Powell Lake. Powell Lake is the last leg of the journey and ends at the world's second smallest river the Powell River. Distance to the end of the canoe route is approximately 29 km, on the left side of the lake you can access Haywire Bay Regional Campsite which is a great overnight stop. Camp area 23 Must be on the water by 8am and off by 12 noon because high winds and 3ft swells hit every day about noon. The size of the campsite's is a problem on this lake. None of them are really big enough, yet you could squeeze in on any of them

August Day 6 Friday

Canoeing (5) around [Powell River/Lake Loop: Mitchell Canoe and Kayak](#): _\$52 CDN. You paddle down to the Shinglemill Marina and the end of the journey. Camp near Powell River overnight with showers

August Day 7 Saturday

Hike to [Brandywine Falls](#) (230 fl) 15 min. hike (not a big time user) Hiking, Shinglemill (Powell Lake) to Upper Sliammon Section 2 Camp Canoe Bay Camping: [Porteau Cove Provincial Park](#) \$10 (group) CDN
