

## T27/V27 Amateur Radio Weekly Net Script

*(Get your radio set up at least 15 minutes before 8:15pm. Do a test broadcast to make sure your radio is working and ask if anyone is monitoring for a radio check. If so, ask if anyone is willing to be a relay station for the night. Note the call sign of the relay station below. At exactly 8:15pm PST start the script.)*

**“Good evening. This is \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ (your name and call sign), net control for the T27/V27 Amateur Radio Net. Is there any emergency or priority traffic?”** *(Pause - if anyone has priority traffic at any time, allow them to handle it before continuing with anything else)*

**“This net may be broken at any time for any emergency or priority traffic. For information on this net see our web site at: [v27.org/hamradio.asp](http://v27.org/hamradio.asp) or send e-mail to [K6GDA@ARRL.NET](mailto:K6GDA@ARRL.NET). This net normally meets Mondays at 8:15PM at 146.415 megahertz. “**

**“The purpose of this net is to support and train Ham Radio Operators for emergency communications. We invite all to use this net to announce Amateur radio events, activities, resources and training in support of the Cities of San Mateo County and the general community. This is a directed net and all traffic should be coordinated by Net Control. Please note that \_\_\_\_\_ (call sign of relay station) has agreed to act as relay for tonight.”**

**“Are there any visitors or guests? Please check in now.”** *(Pause, welcome guests, write down call sign & name, be courteous, direct them to the V27 web site for more information)*

**“Are there any relays?”** *(Pause, welcome guests that come as relays, - - - relays are people that cannot directly reach you so their ham calls are relayed by another Ham monitoring the frequency)*

**“We will now do member check-ins by roll call. The roll call list is on our web site. Please reply with your call sign as called, give a signal report and indicate any Traffic.”** *( Read the call signs in order, pause, and listen for a reply after each call sign. Then acknowledge check-ins.) If something is heard say, “Hello \_\_\_\_\_ (first name of person checking in)” Write down signal report and any traffic - questions or announcements. These will be handled later.*

*If there is nothing heard say, “Nothing Heard” (Occasionally ask if there are any relays and give your name and call sign). At the end of the roll call ask,*

**“Are there any late check ins?”** *( additional T27/V27 Members who wish to check in but missed the initial check in.)*

**“We will now handle traffic”** *(go back through the list and call those indicating traffic)*

*(When check ins are done or at about 8:30 )*

**“Are there any late check ins?” . . . “Thank you for participating in the T27/V27 Amateur Radio Net, This session is now closed. This is \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ (your name and call sign), Net Control”**

*(at this point informal discussion is encouraged)*
